**March 2012:**

We were very pleased to receive an 'Outstanding' mark at the Isle of Wight Musical Competition Festival. Not only did we retain the trophy for our class, we were also awarded a trophy for 'best choir' in the whole competition.



**May 2012:**

'An Evening with Patrick Hawes' at St John's Church in Newport proved to be a hugely successful event and was enjoyed by all. The choir performed a number of Hawes' pieces and were fortunate to work with the composer during a workshop as well as performing under his baton. A review of the concert stated "*the Camerata Choir performed to perfection*".



**July 2012:**

The choir was invited to join forces with choirs across the UK to perform the world premiere of Karl Jenkins' *Gods of Olympus* at the Royal Albert Hall. We also performed *The Armed Man: A Mass for Peace* by the same composer. The event raised funds for the National Autistic Society.

**August 2012:**

The choir participated in the Ventnor Fringe Festival performing a mixed programme of Jenkins and Hawes music at St Catherine's Church in Ventnor.

**September 2012:**

Camerata Chamber Choir was very fortunate to be invited to sing at a concert at St Luke's Church in Grayshott. The choir, alongside Excelsis Choir and Marylebone Camerata Orchestra, performed *The Peacemakers*, a 2012 choral work written by Karl Jenkins. Jenkins himself conducted the sell-out event, receiving a standing ovation by the appreciative audience.
